- 33 A VASE OF 3 STEMS OF CONTRASTING FOLIAGE
- 34 ONE FUCHSIA STEM (max height 46cm measured from the table)
- 35 6 FUCHSIA FLOWERS DISPLAYED
- 36 AN ARRANGEMENT OF MIXED ORNAMENTAL GRASSES AND/OR SEDGES (max width 60cm)
- 37 A VASE OF 3 STEMS OF A SINGLE KIND OF GARDEN FLOWER (eg 3 Michaelmas Daisies or Crocosmia or Japanese Anemones or Gladioli but excluding those in classes 24 - 36)
- 38 A VASE OF MIXED FLOWERS (to be judged on quality and variety of blooms)
- 39 THE LARGEST SUNFLOWER HEAD (diameter measured)

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CRAFT</b></p> <p>69 A PIN CUSHION (max any dimension 10cm)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAKE RECIPE</b></p> <p>225g butter, 225g caster sugar, 4 large eggs, 225g self-raising flour, 100g ground almonds, ½ tsp almond extract, 450g mixed dried fruit. Cream butter &amp; sugar until fluffy; add eggs a little at a time beating well. Mix in flour, almonds &amp; essence and beat. Fold in fruit. Put in 20cm/8in greased cake tin. Cook 160°/140° fan until it passes the 'skewer test' – 1½ to 2 hours.</p>
